



Context of the 2022 SoC

- Publication of the Regulation modifying the Regulation respecting compensation for municipal services provided to recover and reclaim residual materials
- Update of application rules of the SoC

Novelties of the 2022 SoC: Update of application rules

- **Renewal** of the ecodesign incentive **bonus** and the credit for post-consumer recycled content
- Inclusion of **new definitions**
- Introduction of the notion of **practical owner** of a group of companies
- Broadening of targeting criteria to transactional website operators without a business place in Québec
- Ineligibility of voluntary contributors to the flat fee based on the revenue
- Inclusion of articles regarding **newspapers** which must still be reported to RecycleMédias





New material subject to a fee for the 2022 SoC: Wood and cork

- New material subject to a fee
- Examples:
 - Cork stoppers and caps
 - Citrus fruit boxes
 - Cheese boxes



Some plastics have been disaggregated in order to obtain data on generated quantities of these materials





Polypropylene (PP)

- Disaggregated from « other plastics »
- Includes all #5 plastics
- Examples:
 - Hand cream tubes
 - Prescription medicine containers
 - Containers with in-mold labels





Polyvinyl chloride (PVC)

- Disaggregated from « PVC, PLA and other degradable plastics»
- Includes all #3 plastics
- Examples:
 - Clamshell containers for hardware and electronic products
 - Bedding flexible packaging





Polylactic acid (PLA) and other degradable plastics

- Disaggregated from « PVC, PLA and other degradable plastics»
- Includes all #7 plastics made of PLA as well as all degradable or compostable plastics
- Examples:
 - Clamshell containers for croissants or muffins
 - Degradable or compostable shopping bags



New reporting portal

- The ECO-D reporting portal has retired!
- The new reporting portal has officially launched on July 13, in time for the publication of the 2022 SoC!
- A tutorial is available to help users navigate in the new portal





The new portal has a refreshed look and allows more autonomy in the management of company accounts

Context

The ecodesign incentive bonus pilot project has been renewed to support organizations working towards ecodesign for their containers and packaging and encourage others to follow suit.

By offering this bonus, ÉEQ is demonstrating its commitment to supporting the SoC so that it is more linked to the impact of the material along the recovery and recycling value chain.


With the implementation of extender producer responsibility (EPR) and the modernization of curbside recycling, by 2025, businesses will have a leading role in the system and its management.





Objectives

- Recognize ecodesign initiatives for containers and packaging commercialized during the 2021 calendar year;
- **Document** ecodesign strategies, challenges and solution leads;
- Identify environmental gains, as well as positive social and economic benefits;
- Communicate company initiatives that obtain a bonus.





Bonus: what's new?

- Bonus percentage increased to 50% of the payable contribution for designated containers and packaging.
- Maximum of \$25,000 may be granted of each bonus application.
- Possibility of submitting several requests, up to a cumulative bonus of a maximum of \$60,000.
- Minimum of \$5,000 per company, or equal to the company's total contribution, when the total contribution is less than \$5,000.
- Credit note applicable to the contribution balance for the 2022 Schedule of Contributions or a subsequent year.





Who is eligible for the bonus



Eligibility criteria

- Be a contributing company and compliant with ÉEQ
- Complete a detailed report, even if the company is considered a low-volume producer
- Have commercialized one or more ecodesigned containers or packaging during the 2021 calendar year
- Have submitted the bonus application form and supporting documents before the prescribed deadline
- Commit to collaborating with ÉEQ in order to document the initiative and give consent for the publication of your best practices














Example: Ice cream sandwich packaging





Detergent container


Eligible initiative example: improvement of packaging

Description

- High-density polyethylene (HDPE) bottle
- Polypropylene (PP) cap
- Self-adhesive paper label
- 900 000 placed on the market in the 2021 calendar year

Ecodesign actions

- Optimization of wall thicknesses
- Integration of recycled content HDPE (25%)
- Addition of sorting instructions on the bottle
- Conducting and publication of a case study


